



## TUITION FAQ

### IS THERE A DISCOUNT FOR MULTIPLE CHILDREN?

Yes, absolutely. Jackson Catholic Schools is mindful of the financial sacrifices you make to provide your children with the best quality, Catholic education. We want to continue to help you every way we can to make that a reality for you.

#### K-6 Multi-child Discount

At our K-6 schools families receive a 10% discount when two students are enrolled at the same school (\$9,458 total for two elementary students) and an 18% discount when three students are enrolled at the same school (\$12,925 total for three elementary students). Any students enrolled beyond three in a family at the same school cost no additional tuition.

#### Lumen Christi Multi-child Discount

Families receive a 3% discount when they have two students enrolled at Lumen Christi, and a 5% discount with three or more students.

### IS THERE A DISCOUNT IF I PAY IN FULL?

Yes, to receive the full pay discount you must pay by July 31st. At the K-6 schools the full pay discount is 2% and at Lumen Christi it is 3%.

### IS THERE FINANCIAL AID/TUITION ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE?

Yes, all Jackson Catholic Schools and the [Diocese of Lansing](#) offer need-based financial aid. Need is determined by an independent, third-party service, FACTS, which makes its assessment based on income and tax information. However, the FACTS application does have a section that offers the family to list any changes in their financial situation, and these are taken into consideration by the individual schools. Aid from the Diocese and JCS are done by completing the same application. The deadline for [Tuition Assistance](#) is March 2, 2026.

We also participate in the Tuition Reduction Incentive Program (T.R.I.P.) for additional financial assistance.

Additionally, you can also check with your individual school for any additional scholarships or grants that they may provide.

### IS THERE A DISCOUNT FOR BEING CATHOLIC?

Yes, our Catholic identity is core to our mission. At the elementary schools the Parishes already generously support and subsidize the cost of education, but you may reach out to an individual school for any additional scholarships that may be available. At Lumen Christi, families may receive up to \$900 per student, but they must present to their participating parish or priest the Practicing Catholic Scholarship Form.

Currently participating parishes: Queen of the Miraculous Medal (Jackson), St. John the Evangelist (Jackson), St. Mary Star of the Sea (Jackson), St. Rita (Clarklake), Our Lady of Fatima (Michigan Center), St. Mary (Marshall), St. Joseph Shrine (Brooklyn), St. John (Albion), Sacred Heart (Hudson), St. Catherine Laboure (Concord). Each parish may have slightly different methods for handling the form so you are encouraged to talk directly with them. Signing the form, or not, is the sole discretion of the parish. Parishes will return the form to Lumen Christi. Participating parishes will generously contribute \$550 per student toward tuition. Additionally, once the signed letter is received families will automatically have their tuition reduced by \$350 per student.

Families of non-participating parishes: If your parish returns the form indicating your student is a practicing Catholic we will provide the \$350 per student tuition reduction. Please know we are always looking for more parish partners in expanding an accessible and affordable Catholic education and would be happy to talk to your parish.

The deadline for this form is October 1st, but it is strongly encouraged to have them completed before June 1.

### WHAT ARE THE NEW TUITION COSTS?

Please note that the tuition amount listed below represents the standard tuition rate. Because each student and family's situation varies, this amount does not reflect any potential multi-child discounts, the Lumen Christi Practicing Catholic Scholarship, or financial aid.

<b>High School*</b>	\$10,280
<b>Middle School*</b>	\$7,574
<b>Elementary</b>	\$5,254
<b>PreSchool-Full Time**</b>	\$5,575

\*This does not include the annual student fee (\$375 for grades 7-8 and \$450 for grades 9-12) that covers things like textbooks, technology fees, retreats, field trips, class fees, and yearbook.

\*\*Each school offers a variety of preschool options from full time to part time, and those prices are prorated based on time.

### WHAT ARE THE RE-ENROLLMENT FEE DEADLINES?

<b>January 23rd - January 31st</b>	\$50
<b>February 1st - February 14th</b>	\$150
<b>February 15th - March 1st</b>	\$200
<b>After March 1st</b>	\$250
